CCH offers scholarships for diabetes camp

(COLUMBUS, Neb.) – Columbus Community Hospital is making scholarships available for area youth with Type 1 diabetes to attend camp.

Summer camp experiences for children living with diabetes provide fun activities in an inclusive environment. Camp Floyd Rogers and Camp Hot Shots are two such opportunities in Nebraska.

Held near Cozad, Camp Floyd Rogers is for children age 8-18. Camp Hot Shots is geared toward children age 6-11 and takes place at Platte River State Park.

Those attending either camp can apply for a scholarship to help offset the cost. The dollar amount of each scholarship will be determined by the number of applicants.
