Columbus Community Hospital Considers Bringing a Field House to the Community

(COLUMBUS, Neb.) – As part of its commitment to improving the health of the communities it serves, Columbus Community Hospital is exploring several initiatives to provide additional health and wellness opportunities for area residents.

One initiative under consideration is a multipurpose, field house that would provide exercise and wellness opportunities for all ages. Field houses are large buildings that are used for various forms of athletic events, as well as for housing athletic equipment. They traditionally have spectator seating and changing facilities.

The Columbus Community Hospital board of directors and hospital administration are currently researching the feasibility of opening a field house in Columbus. As part of their research, they are visiting other communities who have recently added a field house.
