**(COLUMBUS, Neb.)** – Columbus Community Hospital is proud to care for our new neighbors, who are arriving daily. CCH’s Maternal Child Health Department offers a caring and progressive environment for new mothers and their families.

The Maternal Child Health Department delivers about 600 babies each year and works in collaboration with local obstetricians and physicians to care for patients.

The department’s secure unit includes many rooms designed to make new mothers and babies feel at ease, including four labor/delivery/recovery rooms, eight postpartum rooms and two observation rooms.

CCH’s Maternal Child Health Department has access to three pediatric physicians who are available 24 hours a day. Its staff of RNs and LPNs care for mothers and their babies during labor and delivery, provide mother/baby care, neonatal intensive care services, and care for both pediatric patients (less than four months old) and patients recovering from gynecological surgeries.

In addition to the care provided, CCH is pleased to offer some of the latest advancements in maternal and child health, as well as other special touches to make new parents’ birthing experiences the best they can be. For example, when patients’ babies are born, Braham's Lullaby is played on CCH’s overhead paging system so that the entire hospital can share in the new parents’ joy.

Staff at CCH also strive to provide new parents with the education they need to best care for themselves and their new babies. With that in mind, the Maternal Child Health Department offers childbirth classes, tours of the unit, as well as baby care and breastfeeding classes.
