**Jenna Meister honored with DAISY Award for Extraordinary Nurses
at Columbus Community Hospital**

Bybee then described a specific instance in which Meister comforted a grieving family after a patient’s death.

“Jenna was patient and kind during the entire event, never showing anything but kindness and care,” Bybee wrote. “Jenna is the perfect example of a nurse who loves her patients, cares about her patients and is there to support them during times of grief.

Meister was honored with an award presentation on July 27.
