(COLUMBUS, Neb.) – Columbus Community Hospital will be hosting the Precious H.E.A.R.T.S. (Healing, Embracing and Remembering Through Sharing) interfaith memorial service at 1:30 p.m. Saturday, Oct. 9, at Roselawn Cemetery, located near 23rd Street and 3rd Avenue in Columbus.

This annual memorial service takes place each October to coincide with National Pregnancy Loss and Infant Death Month. Individuals who have experienced a pregnancy loss are welcome to attend, along with their family and friends.
