Senior behavioral health unit virtual tour available

(COLUMBUS, Neb.) – Anyone interested in an inside look at Columbus Community Hospital’s new senior behavioral health unit can check out a virtual tour of the facility.

The tour, now available on the hospital’s website at www.columbushosp.org/our_services/senior_behavioral_health_unit.aspx, gives viewers a peek at patient rooms, bathrooms, treatment areas and nurses’ stations. It also introduces you to some of the key staff members in the unit. If a family is considering admitting a loved one to the unit, the tour can give them peace of mind about what the patient will be experiencing.

The senior behavioral health unit is a place where older adults with behavioral or emotional issues can find the treatment they need. The staff includes a psychiatrist and advanced practitioner, nurses, social worker, a recreational therapist and a dietitian.

“Our goal is to create a safe environment where your loved one will receive care and return to the community in the least restrictive setting possible,” said Ed Thornbrugh, program director for the senior behavioral health unit.
