Survey shows volunteers feel valued

(COLUMBUS, Neb.) – The results are in, and the message is clear: Columbus Community Hospital volunteers love what they do.

Beginning this year, CCH conducted a formal, anonymous survey of its volunteers to learn how it can best support them. A total of 82 adult volunteers and VolunTeens participated in the 2021 survey.

All the volunteers surveyed answered that they are proud to tell people they volunteer for CCH. They all also agreed they would recommend CCH as a good place to volunteer.

“Our volunteers are the backbone of our hospital,” said Amy Blaser, vice president of physician relations and business development. “Their feedback is incredibly important to us. I am eager to look at the individual comments to learn what improvements we can make to our volunteer program.”

In the survey:

- 98% of respondents said they were a satisfied volunteer.
- 97% of respondents said they feel CCH treats volunteers with respect.
- 100% of respondents said they believe CCH provides high-quality care and service.
- 95% of respondents said their volunteer work is meaningful.
