

OUR HOSPITAL

Our 47-bed acute care hospital is certified for swing beds with an additional 14 ambulatory outpatient beds and 4 skilled nursing beds. Established in 1972 by the merger of St. Mary's Hospital and Behlen Memorial Hospital, this not-for-profit hospital is governed by a local board of directors. We are licensed by the Nebraska State Board of Health and accredited by the Joint Commission.

We are a member of the Nebraska Hospital Association (NHA), the American Hospital Association (AHA), Voluntary Hospital Association (VHA) and Heartland Health Alliance (HHA).

OUR FACILITY

- Columbus Community Hospital is a **153,000** square foot hospital building constructed in 2002 and located on 80-acres in the northwest part of Columbus.
- **In 2012**, the Hospital completed a **30,000** square foot addition. This allowed for expansion in the Emergency Department, increasing patient privacy in the registration area and created a women's imaging center.
- **In fall 2015**, the Hospital collaborated with the **YMCA** to open the Columbus Wellness Center on adjacent property. Most of the Rehabilitative Services department moved to the Columbus Wellness Center and the pediatric rehabilitation service, Wiggles & Giggles Therapy for Kids™, moved from their off-site location.
- In August 2017, CCH-owned **Child Care Center** was completed. The Child Care Center accommodates up to 101 children and gives CCH employees a convenient child care option.
- Our Hospital offers inpatient and outpatient care, surgery, and **24-hour** emergency care.
- **Two aquatic therapy locations** with Rehabilitative Services at the Columbus Wellness Center and Premier Physical Therapy.
- The Hospital's south campus houses offices for medical outreach services of Home Health and Hospice, Healthy Families and Occupational Health Services.

1 FIRST FLOOR:

- **Gift Shop** - *No latex balloons allowed in facility.*
- **Meditation Room**
- **Wall of Water** - *Donated by the Dr. Ronald Ernst Family.*
- **Foundation/Donor Wall**
- **Registration** - *All patients report here first.*
Registration is closed after 8:30 pm.
The emergency entrance on the west handles admissions after the 8:30pm time frame.
 - o Insurance and Billing - 86,368 outpatient claims and 2,679 inpatient claims in 2017
 - o Central Registration - 66,983 individuals came through admissions in 2017
- **Patient Services**
- **Laboratory** - *Main lab is located in the medical office building.*
- **Respiratory Therapy** - *18,721 inpatient and outpatient treatments done in 2017*
- **Emergency Room** - *Available 24/7-11,898 visits in 2017*
 - o After Hours Admission Desk/Lifeline - security
 - o Emergency Rooms - Total of 10 exam rooms, including 2 trauma bays, a decontamination room, holding and triage
 - o Ambulance bay with alcove and EMS room
 - o Designated helicopter pad

 - o Fourth space is available for future needs
 - o Overhead booms provide electrical, video cabling, medical gasses, & oxygen

2 SECOND FLOOR:

- **Patient Rooms**
 - o Mini-stations, 4 rooms per nurse
 - o 36-private rooms with private bathroom
 - o 2,679 Inpatients in 2017
- **Waiting Area for 2nd Floor** - *staff at desk will help direct guests and controls access into the Maternal Child Health Unit (MCH).*
- **Infusion Services** - *973 infusion procedures in 2017*
- **Maternal Child Health Unit (OB)**
 - o Emphasis on Infant Security
 - o 8 Post Partum Rooms, 4 LDR's 2 Observation Rooms, a Cesarean Suite and a Family Living Room
 - o 619 births in 2017
 - o Visiting Hours - no one allowed before 11:00am unless immediate family.
- **Simulation Lab/Computerized Mannequins**
 - o Four life-like human patient simulators.
 - o Build critical thinking skills & training to staff and students.

 - o *Private rooms, home-like environment*
- **Swing Bed** - *5 beds*
 - o Sub-acute care
 - o Rehab-focused
- **Conference Center** - *Prairie, Pawnee, & Platte*
- **Cardiopulmonary Rehab**
 - o In 2017, there were 854 cardiac stress tests performed, 2,936 cardiac rehab visits, 558 pulmonary rehab visits, & 13,495 total visits with 11,153 visits in the Wellness program.

 - o 15,435 physical therapy treatments in 2017
 - o Home Health visits - Physical Therapy, Occupational Therapy, and Speech Therapy - 1,978 Total in 2017
 - o Occupational Therapy - 4,514 patients in 2017
