Years of behind-the-scenes work have gone into our \$35-million expansion and renovation project. But next week, the work will no longer be behind-the-scenes.

On Monday, April 22, cones, barrels and fencing will be placed in the North parking lot to create a worksite for JE Dunn Construction – the project’s construction manager. This will remain their worksite for a large portion of the next two years.

PARKING

JE Dunn’s worksite in the North parking lot will eliminate 120 staff parking spaces. To accommodate this loss, additional lot space will be created this summer. Until then, we are asking employees to park in the South parking lot. Staff should park as far south in the outer rings of the South lot as possible to allow spaces closer to the hospital for patients.



There will still be reserved spaces for physicians, SPD, Rehab and handicap parking in the North lot. Once the construction fencing is put up, employees who are still able to park in the North lot can enter through the double doors between ED and Radiology. We will construct a vestibule in that area to reduce the wind flowing into and out of those doors. We will also change the badge access to allow all staff to enter there.

If you park in the South lot and get here before 5:30 a.m., you will need to enter through the ED entrance as the main entrance is not open until 5:30 a.m.

SAFETY

As construction begins, we urge our employees to follow these safety tips to protect themselves, as well as the JE Dunn staff who will be hard at work around our facility:

- Drive slowly around the construction zone
- Be alert for increased pedestrian traffic around the work zone
- Obey posted parking and construction signs
- Give yourself extra time to find a parking space
- Maintain a safe distance between other cars, construction equipment and construction workers
